## **Dundas Seniors' Programs:**

### **Dundas Community Services**

- Transportation to and from medical appointments
- Security Check: in partnership with Canada Post
- Friendly Visits: Volunteers visit with seniors
- Grocery Shopping Program: Volunteers take seniors shopping
- Meals on Wheels
- Friendly Phone Calling: A volunteer with similar interests calls seniors, usually once per week.
- Intervention and Assistance: Staff will assist in filling out government forms for Canada Pension, Old Age Security, Guaranteed Income Supplement, etc.
- Caregiver Education: Seminars offer support to caregivers of older adults. Professionals from many areas provide information and education on topics of interest to the community.
- Income Tax Clinics for individuals with limited income
- Annual Seniors' Fair in June
